City of Dana Point's Annual Emergency Preparedness EXPO

On August 28, 2010 from 10 AM to 2 PM, the City will host its annual Emergency Preparedness EXPO to showcase the variety of equipment and resources available to respond to emergencies. Displays will include helicopters, vehicles and equipment from the Orange County Sheriff's Department, Orange County Fire Authority, U.S. Coast Guard, National Guard, Doctor's Ambulance, and many other organizations. A helicopter rescue winching operation will be demonstrated by the U.S. Coast Guard at approximately 12:00 PM, and various fire equipment will be demonstrated throughout the day.

More than 30 vendors and agency exhibits will present an assortment of information and supplies to help citizens prepare for emergencies, with the first 500 families in attendance receiving free emergency kit supplies.
